DATE AND PLACE

9th-11th January 2026 Eslöv Sport arena, Onsjövägen 3, Eslöv

EVENTS AND TOURNAMENT FORMAT

Friday 9 January

Morning (start earliest 9.00 AM)

Men's Open and Women's Open

Group stage with three players in each group.

The top two best players advance to the knock-out stage. 16 or 8 highest ranked players are directly qualified for the knock-out stage.

Afternoon and evening

Men and Women U21 (born 2005 or later)

Group stage with three players in each group.

The top two best players advance to the knock-out stage. The 16 or 8 highest ranked players are directly qualified for the knock-out stage.

The final rounds of the knock-out stage will be played on Saturday.

Saturday 10th January

Morning (start earliest 9.00 AM)

Boys and Girls 14 (born 2011 or later)

Group stage with four players in each group. The top two best players advance to the knock-out stage, starting on Saturday. The final rounds of the knock-out stage will be finished on Sunday.

Afternoon and evening

Men and Women U19 (born 2007 or later)

Group stage with three players in each group. The top two best players advance to the knock-out stage. 16 or 8 players are directly qualified for the Knock-out stage.

Boys and Girls 13 (born 2012 or later) Knockout event.

Sunday 11th January

Morning (start earliest 9.00 AM)

Boys and Girls 12 (born 2013 or later)

Group stage with four players in each group. The top two best players advance to the knock-out stage.

Boys and Girls 16 (born 2009 or later)

Group stage with three to four players in each group. The top two players advance to the knock-out stage. 16 or 8 players are directly qualified for the knock-out stage.

LIMITATION ON PARTICIPATIONS

Maximum one event per pass (morning and afternoon/evening respectively). This means that participants in Boys Under 14 are not allowed to play Men Under 19 as well as participants in Boys/Girls Under 12 cannot play in Boys/Girls Under 16.

SEEDING

All classes are seeded in accordance with STTA's Competition Rules. All Sweden Tour events are seeded. The current ranking is the basis for the seeding, both for Swedish players and for foreign players with Swedish rankings. Regarding the seeding of foreign players, the competition management makes a preliminary seeding that is reviewed by STTA's seeding committee.

Registration has to be made by email to thomas.andersson@greencargo.com latest December 21st 2025. Please provide name, year and date of birth and events. All Your registration will be confirmed.

In connection with the last day of registration, places must first be prepared for registered foreign players, then each event is filled according to ranking until the maximum number per event is reached. Those whose place cannot be prepared are put on a reserve list for the respective event. Immediately after the last day of registration, all registered associations will be notified of which places have been prepared in the competition, and which are on the reserve list.

PRIZE POOL

Total prize pool is 64.000 SEK

This is divided between Men and Women Open as well as in the U21 and U19 events.

Men and Women Open: Winner 8.000 SEK, Runner-up 4.000 SEK, losing semifinals 2.000 SEK, losing quarterfinal 1.000 SEK.

Men and Women Under 21 and Under 19: Winner 1.500 SEK, Runner-up 1.000 SEK, losing semifinals 500 SEK, losing quarterfinal 500 SEK.

Prize money is not paid out in cash but to the account number provided by the prize winner.

Eventual taxes are paid by the players themselves according to each country's tax. In the youth events Under 13 to Under 16, players placed 1, 2, 3, 3 will participate in the prize giving. The first eight in these events will receive merchandise prizes.

OTHER

The competition uniform of the respective association must be used. Time-out and coaching are allowed.
